



Pablo Quirno was appointed Minister of Foreign Affairs, International Trade, and Worship of the Argentine Republic since October 2025.

From December 2023 to October 2025 he served as Secretary of Finance under the Ministry of Economy, responsible for the strategy and execution of the Treasury's financing program and Argentina's international financial relations as deputy representative of the G20 in the financial sphere and Argentina's deputy governor at the IMF, the World Bank, the IADB, among other multilateral institutions.

From 2016 to 2018, Mr. Quirno held various positions in the public sector, serving as director of the Central Bank of Argentina in 2018 and Chief of Staff at the Ministry of Finance of Argentina from 2016 to 2018.

Previously, he held various positions in the private sector as a financial advisor and was Co-Head of M&A Latin America at JPMorgan in New York.

Mr. Quirno holds a bachelor's degree of Science in Economics from the Wharton School at the University of Pennsylvania.
